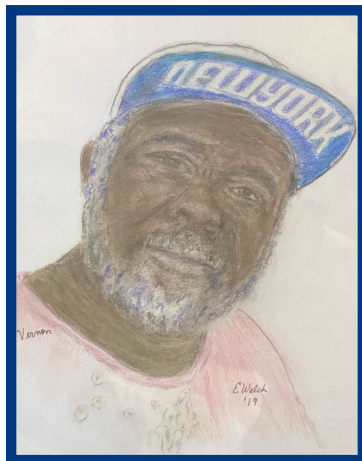


In Memory of Veron W. “Boyo” Edwards
