On December 21, 1935, she was united in marriage to Lee E. Williams of Lucas, SD. To this union a son, Robert Lee, and a daughter, Marietta Marie, were born.

In 1938, they moved to Seattle, WA, and returned in 1943, where they farmed. In 1946, they moved south of Winner, SD, where they bought their own farm. Fadora taught rural school for 8 years and had her children and three nieces as students. In 1955, they moved to Gregory and started Williams Furniture and Appliance Store. Fadora kept busy as bookkeeper, housewife, and grandmother.

They sold their business in 1974 and traveled to all 50 states of the union and Canada, settling in Glendale, AZ, in 1977. In 1984, they moved to a retirement community in Youngstown, AZ.


She was preceded in death by her husband, Lee; her parents; three sisters; and two brothers.
