Donald Charles Workentine was born November 30, 1931, to Sara (Willms) and Jacob Workentine in Dresden, ND, and died January 16, 2022, at Department of Affairs Fort Meade VA Hospital in Hospice care.

Donald graduated from high school at Greenbush, MN, in 1950, and received a \$100.00 scholarship that he used at Concordia College in Moorhead, MN. He graduated with honors in 1954, with a major in English and a minor in German. He taught English in Zeeland, ND, and

Grace City, ND, followed by 2 years in the Army. He was stationed in Germany as a tank commander in the 4<sup>th</sup> armored division. After his discharge he taught 11 years in Carrington, ND. It was there he met and married his wife, Doris Paulson, and they had 3 sons.

He is preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Gary, and Lloyd; sisters, Frances, Joyce, and Florence.


