

Walter "Walt" A. Simons, 93, passed away Saturday, January 27, 2024 at Monument Health Sturgis Hospital.

Walter Allen Simons was born September 29, 1930 to Sam and Ada (Burditt) Simons in Sturgis, SD. Walt grew up in Marcus. He attended Sturgis Brown High School, and after graduation he attended Black Hills State Teachers College. Walt taught school for a short time, before joining the US Air Force during the Korean War. After he was honorably discharged from the Air Force, he began a banking career with the National Bank of South

Dakota, eventually being transferred back to Sturgis. Walt married Barbara Newbill on August 27, 1955. He then began working as an insurance agent and selling real estate. He was a realtor at Century 21 for a time, before starting Walt Simons Real Estate and Auctions.



Walt was involved in starting the Black Hills Chapter of the Christian Trail Riders of

America, and was a member of the Sturgis Veterans of Foreign Wars and American Legion. Walt was also a member of the Sturgis Police Reserves and Kiwanis Club.



He is survived by his wife, Barbara; children, Larry Simons, Portland, OR, Colette Meyers, Sturgis, Lisa (Duane) Baker, Sturgis; sister, Freda Wilson, Sturgis; four grandchildren, Lyndee (Brandon) Fogelman, Dustin (Amber) Brink, Brian Baker, Stephanie (Scott) Hughes and six great-grandchildren, Grace Fogelman, Avery Fogelman, Marshall Brink, Brandon, Caleb and Sam Hughes; along with many nieces and nephews. 
