

Patricia Ann Soden

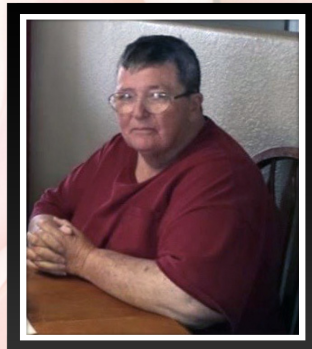

Patricia "Pat" Ann Soden passed away Thursday July 30, 2020, at her residence in Sturgis, South Dakota.

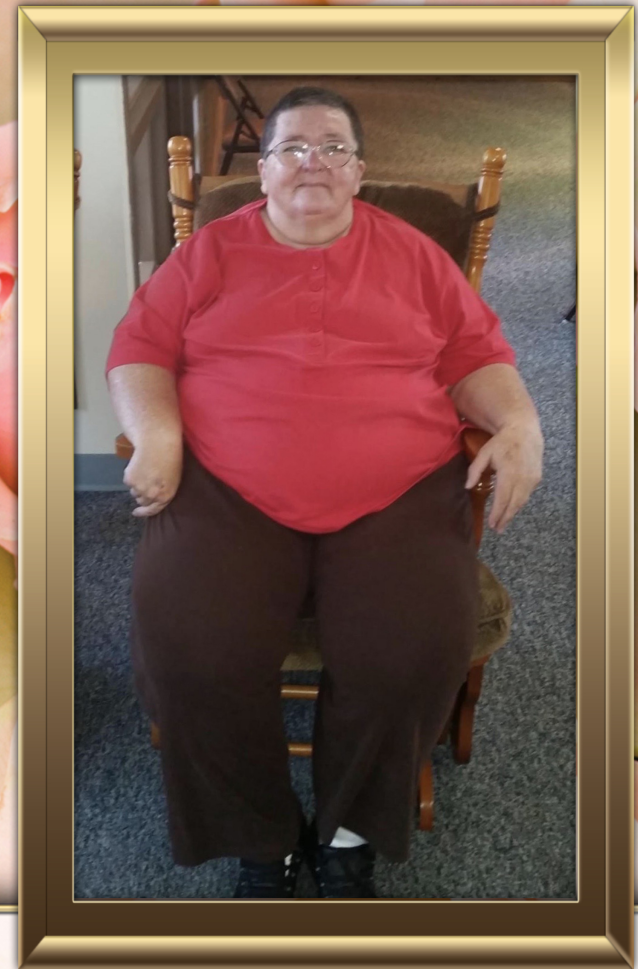

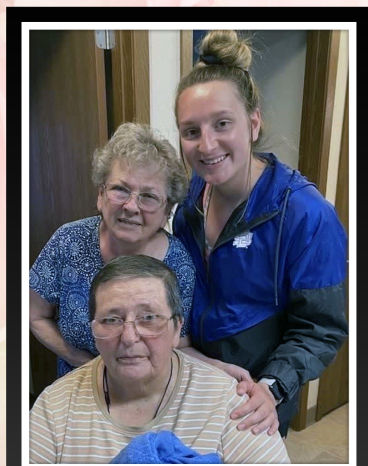
*The day you left and gained your wings
