Don went to work for Meade County Highway Department as a mechanic and retired as the Assistant Highway Superintendent. Don's best years were spent on his Dad's ranch with his horse between his knees.

Don was a scout leader with the Plainview Rangers. Upon retirement he enjoyed gardening, woodworking, fishing and gold prospecting and some winters in Arizona.

Surviving are his two sons, Wesley and Ron; daughter Berniece, sister, Arlene; and a very special granddaughter, Jennifer; along with numerous nieces, nephews, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, sister, two brothers, two sons; Bart and Danny.

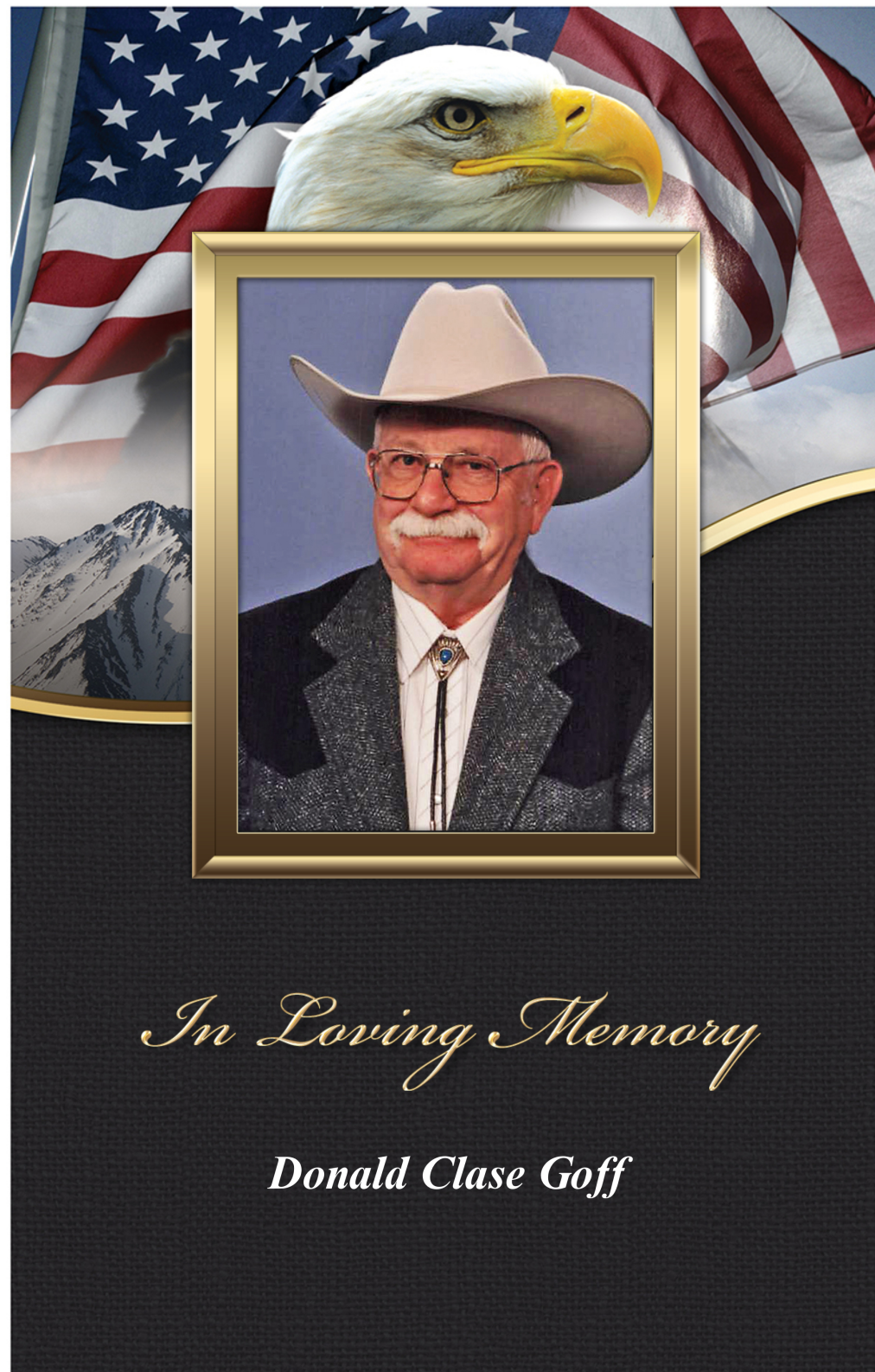
