OBITUARY

LIFE & LEGACY

GEORGE JUNIOR TRIPLETT WAS BORN ON JULY 16, 1940, IN PHILADELPHIA, MISSISSIPPI, TO THE LATE LUTHER DAVIS TRIPLETT AND BONNIE RUTH REYNOLDS TRIPLETT. THE ELDEST OF EIGHT CHILDREN, GEORGE WAS A PILLAR OF STRENGTH FOR HIS FAMILY. HE WAS A FAITHFUL AND ACTIVE MEMBER OF MT. ARY BAPTIST CHURCH UNTIL HIS HEALTH DECLINED, AND HIS LIFE REFLECTED UNWAVERING DEDICATION TO FAITH, FAMILY, AND HARD WORK.

GEORGE RELOCATED TO CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, WHERE HE MARRIED THE LATE DOROTHY TRIPLETT, AND SIX CHILDREN WERE BORN TO THIS UNION: DEBORAH TRIPLETT, GEORGE TRIPLETT JR., DENISE TRIPLETT, TERRY TRIPLETT, JANICE TRIPLETT, AND RENEE TRIPLETT. IN 1966, HE RETURNED TO PHILADELPHIA, MISSISSIPPI, WHERE HE WORKED FAITHFULLY AT U.S. MOTOR FOR SEVERAL YEARS. IN 1969, GEORGE MARRIED MARY JUANITA BURNSIDE TRIPLETT, AND FOUR CHILDREN WERE BORN TO THIS UNION: WILLIE TRIPLETT, BILLY TRIPLETT, JAMES TRIPLETT, AND MARY TRIPLETT. BEFORE HIS ILLNESS, GEORGE ENJOYED FISHING AND LAWN WORK, WHICH BROUGHT HIM PEACE AND FULFILLMENT.



WE'LL ALWAYS KNOW YOU BY YOUR LAUGH,

OUR GREATEST LEGACY OF ALL.






GOD GRAND-DAUGHTERS
