## Obituary

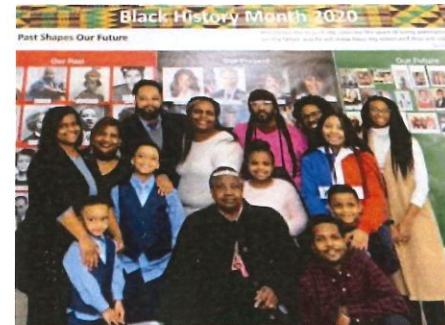
