Paul Leo "Papa" Fischer was born February 28, 1952, at McLaughlin, SD, to Theophil Antone and MaryAnn (Day) Fischer.

While serving in the US Army, Paul received the following decorations; sharpshooter with the M16, expert .45 caliber pistol, Good Conduct Medal (3), National Defense Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon,

Following his honorable discharge he attended vocational school and earned a degree in cabinet making.

Paul was diagnosed in 1985 with Hairy Cell Leukemia and was diagnosed in 2008 with Pulmonary Hypertension.


His grandchildren were his pride and joy. The family requests casual attire for the services.
