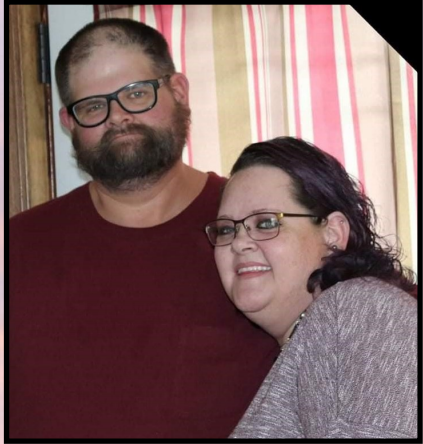


Ron Sterling Adcock
