



Lavon Ann Blinsmon, age 88, died Sunday, May 31st, 2020, at the Good Samaritan Village in Sioux Falls, SD.

Lavon (Sandner) Blinsmon was born on March 20th, 1932, to Peter and Elsie (Wegener) Sandner in Salem, SD; the oldest of eight children.
