

Marvin Edward Sharp, 89, Sturgis, died July 1, 2019, at Sanford Medical Center in Sioux Falls, SD.

During his grade school and high school years, he worked on the family farm and helped his father at the gas station and mechanic shop. During that time, he also worked his way up the ranks to Staff Sargent. Marvin had very fond memories of his time stationed in England, and his favorite Air Force Base in the USA was Shreveport, LA.


