He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Clarence Habermann; great-grandfather, Elvin Koistinen; and his great-grandmother, Betty Richard.

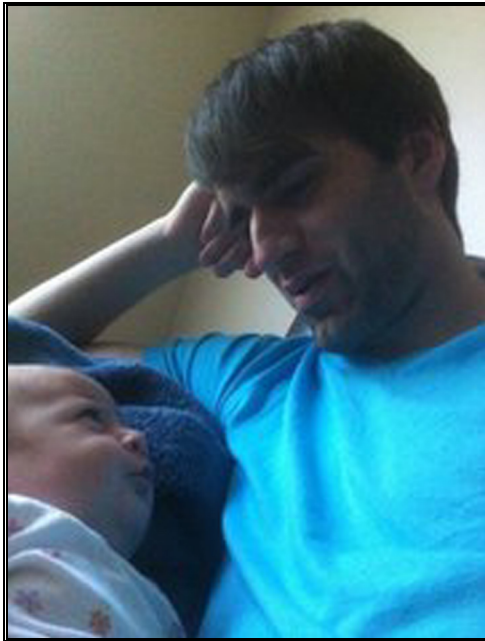
