

Opal Nelson Stomprud

Opal was born at White Butte, SD, on November 18, 1919, to Oscar and Lerie (Braddock) Gordon. She graduated from high school at Haynes, ND, in 1937. She worked at a drugstore, the ASCS office, and as a waitress. She also worked in the welfare office at the court house in Bowbells, ND.



She was married to Lloyd Nelson in Hettinger, ND, on November 18, 1941. They lived in Kenmare, ND, and farmed on her inlaws homestead. In 1954, they moved to Fort Collins, CO, and returned to Haynes in 1956. In 1962, they moved back to Kenmare where she was a member of the Elmdale Lutheran Church in Niobe, ND. Her husband, Lloyd, died on February 19, 1990.
