FOR EVER.

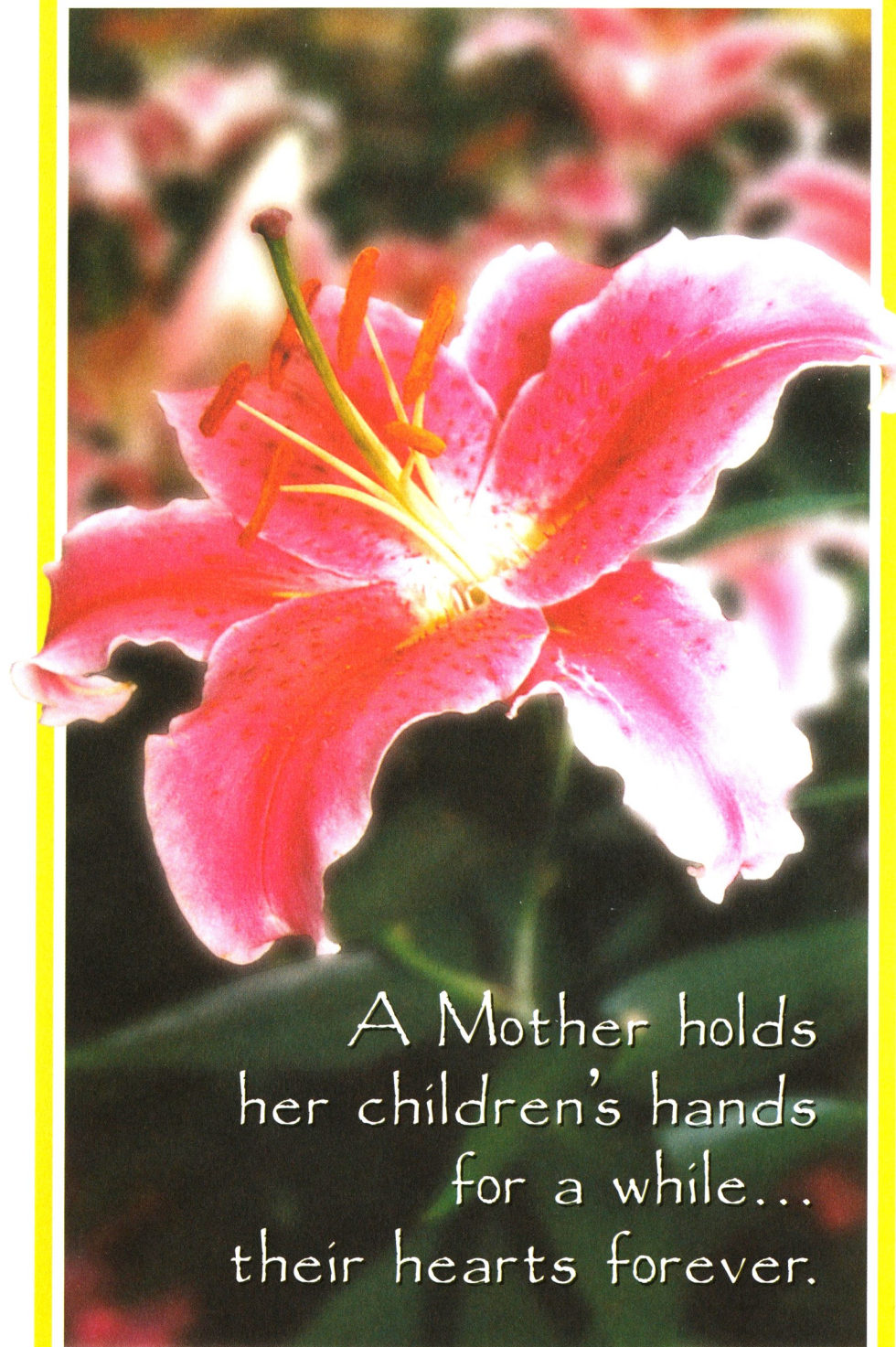
