Larry was preceded in death by his mother.

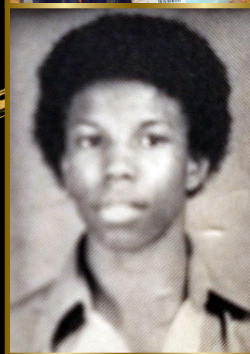
