Mother Evelyn Wright Bryant was born on May 31, 1931, to the late Rev. Alfred C. Wright, Sr. and Agnes Whetsell Wright. She was raised in a loving, faith-centered home where strong values, compassion for others, and dedication to God were instilled early in her life. On Friday, January 23, 2026, Mother Bryant peacefully transitioned from this life at the age of 94, surrounded by the comfort of her home and the legacy of a life well lived.

Mother Bryant was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and faithful servant of God. In 1966, she united in holy matrimony with the late Antley Bryant, and together they shared years of love, commitment, and family. Known for her gentle spirit and strong work ethic, she spent her younger years caring for her family while enjoying cooking and sewing skills she lovingly shared and used to bless those around her. She also worked diligently as a housekeeper, always taking pride in honest work and service.

Later in life, Mother Bryant pursued certification as a nursing assistant, a calling that perfectly matched her nurturing heart. She dedicated 21 years of faithful service at White Oak Manor Nursing Home, where she was known not only for her professionalism, but for her deep compassion. She went beyond her required duties, often purchasing necessities for her patients and offering comfort, conversation, and companionship especially to those who had few or no visitors. After retiring, Mother Bryant devoted herself fully to ministry at Summerville Miracle Revival Center Church. She served faithfully as a missionary and later as a respected member of the Mother's Board. Alongside her beloved sister, the late Mother Jannette Edwards, she remained steadfast in attending worship services, revivals, and church events, setting an enduring example of faithfulness, unity, and dedication to God's work.
