WHAT SHALL I SAY ABOUT THE I rish

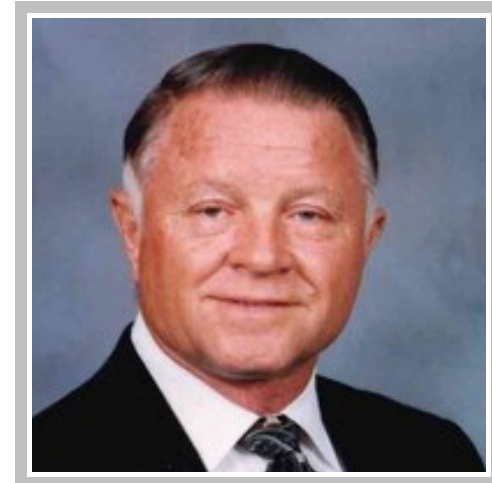
The utterly impractical, never predictable,
