Just look for me and love me, as you know I loved you.*

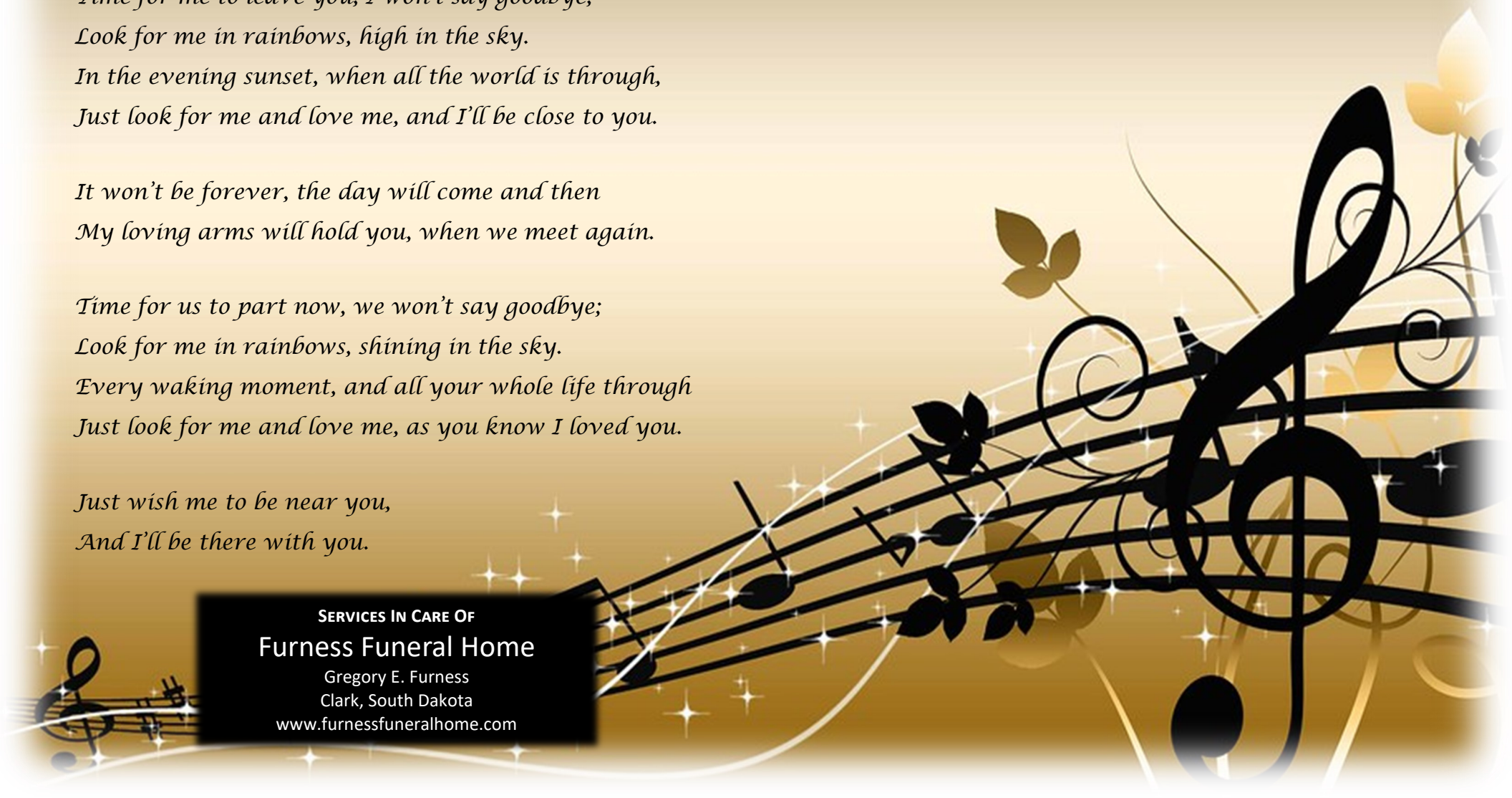
