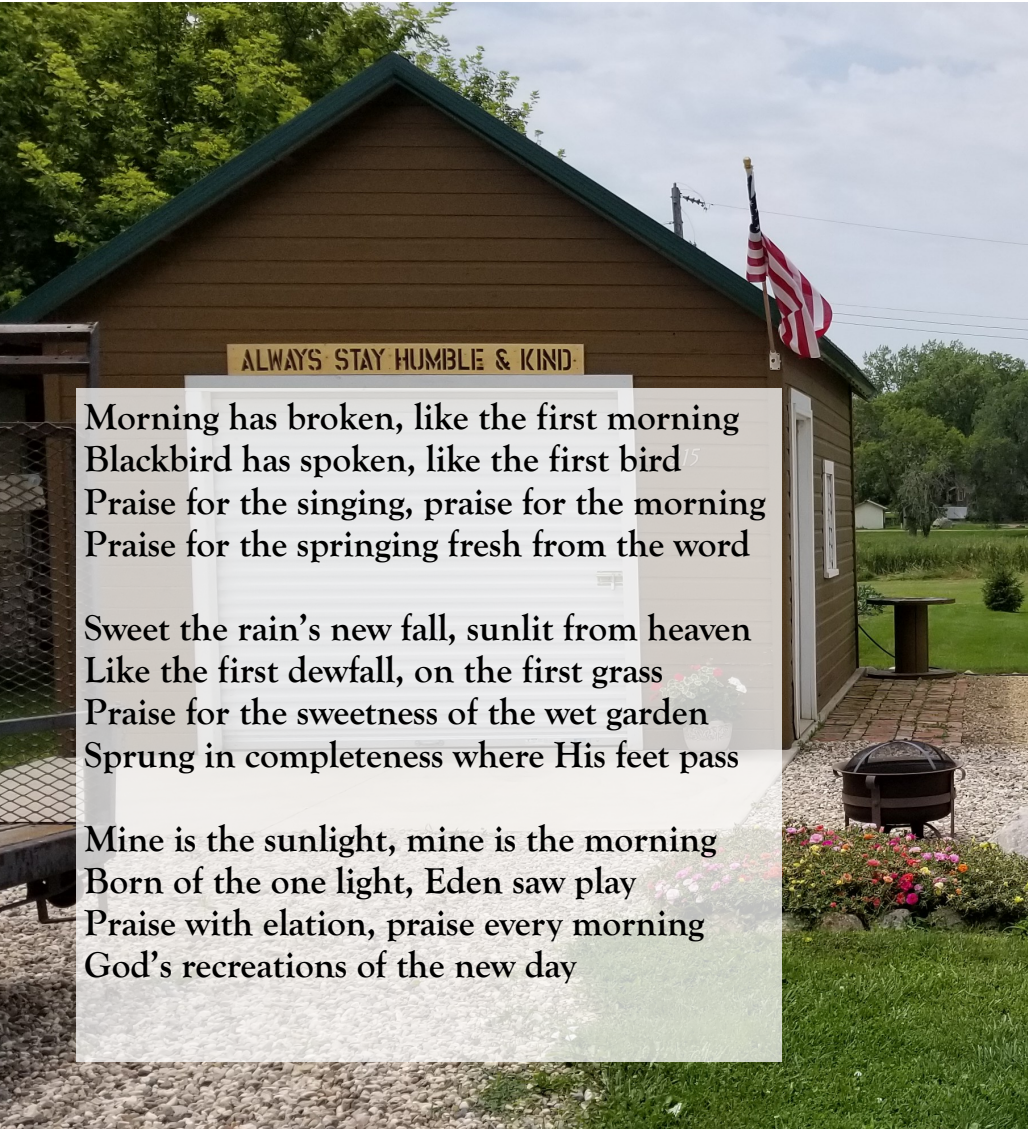




Morning has broken, like the first morning

Praise for the springing fresh from the word

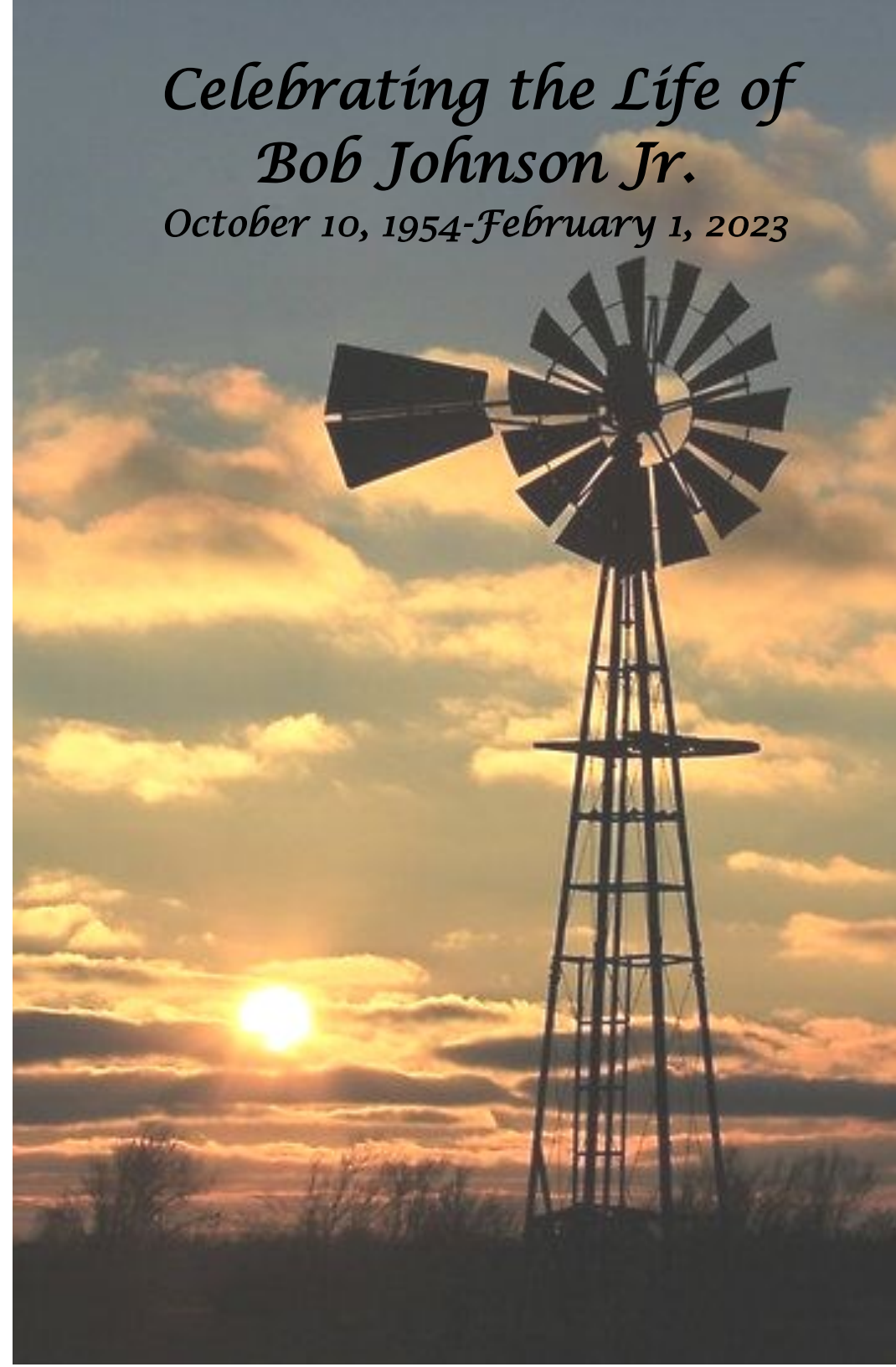
Sweet the rain's new fall, sunlit from heaven
