## *The Family's Message of Gratitude*

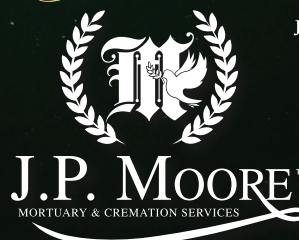

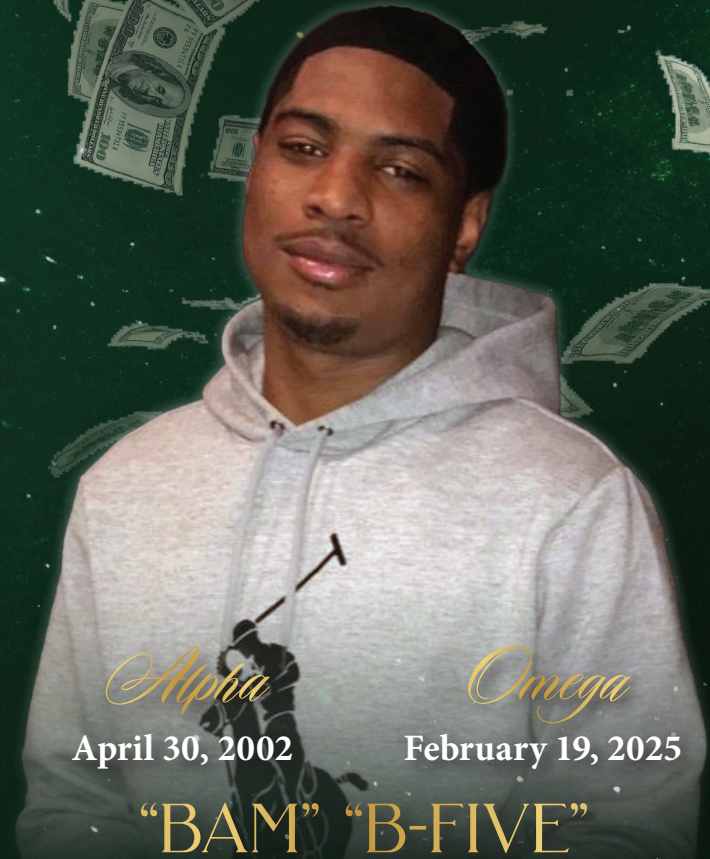
