She loved this job because of her passion for children, especially at the elementary school. She also housed delinquent teens when Timmy was in school never shutting the door or fridge to them whether she could afford it or not. Her biggest passion was reading. She always had at least one or two books with her that she was reading. Paula was currently working at Judy's Place, an assisted living facility, in Belle Fourche. She loved working with the residents there.
