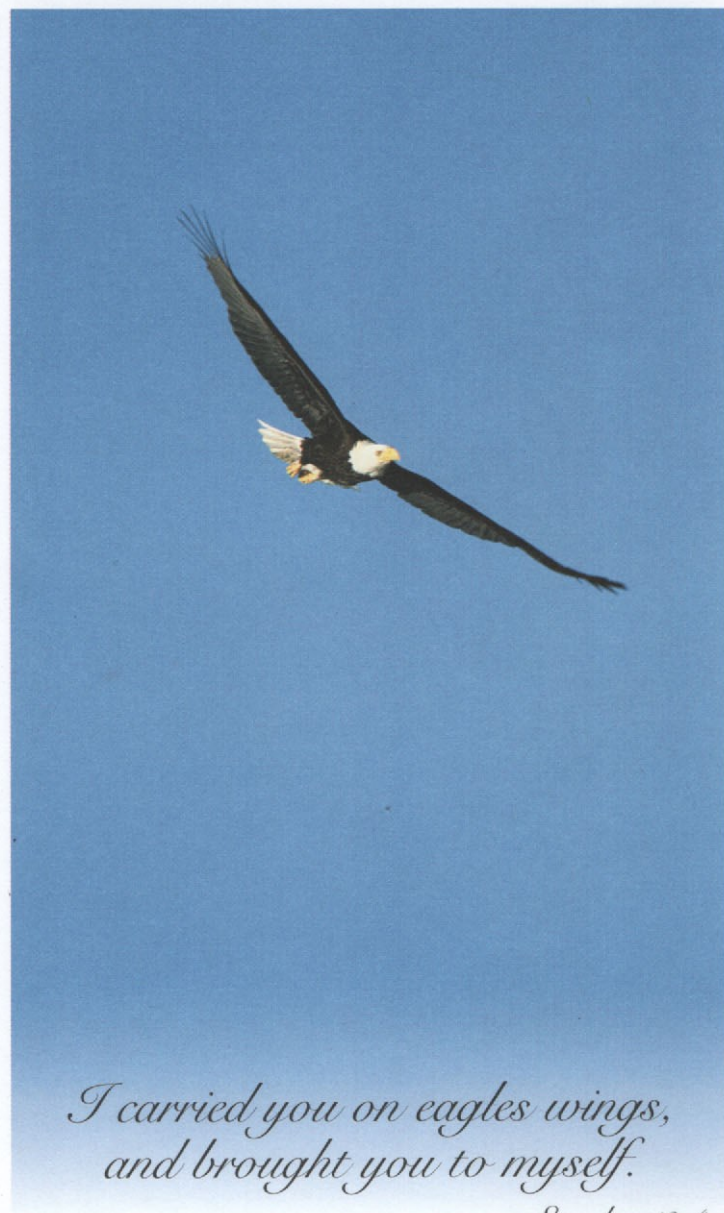

For all of her married life, she worked as a homemaker, where they raised five children, James, Judith, Ann, Mary and Michael. She worked at the Riverside Motel, Reminder Printing, Taylor Audio & Visual and for the Donut Shoppe as a waitress, coffee maker and cleaner when the shop closed for the day. In the

early 1970s she started to collect Red Wing pottery. She traveled to the annual convention in Red Wing, Minnesota every year for almost 30 years, only to stop in the later years due to her failing health. She also was very active in the South Dakota Chapter of the Red Wing Collectors. Mary also loved to sing in the Sweet Adeline's Group and St. Martins' church choir.
