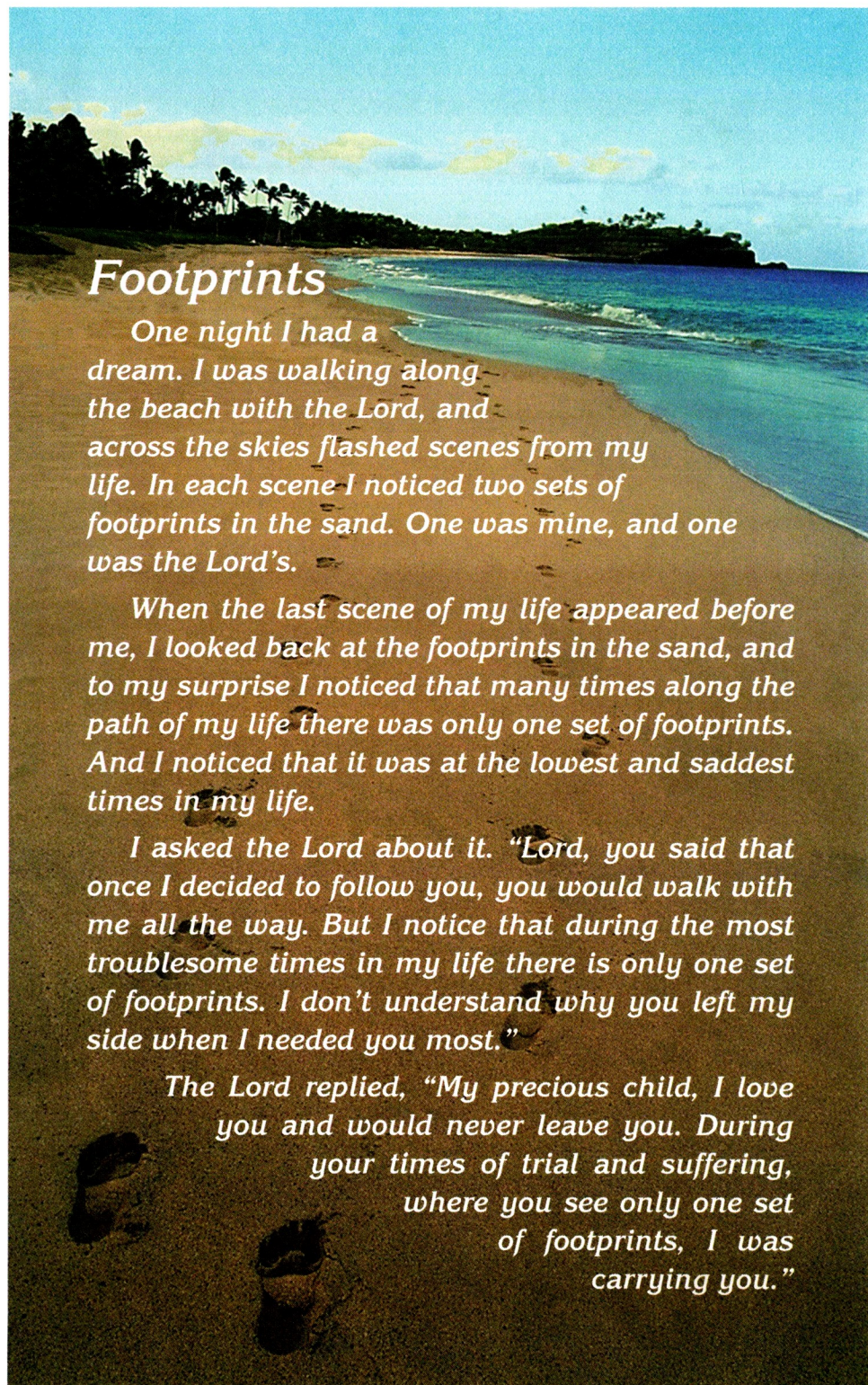
Footprints
