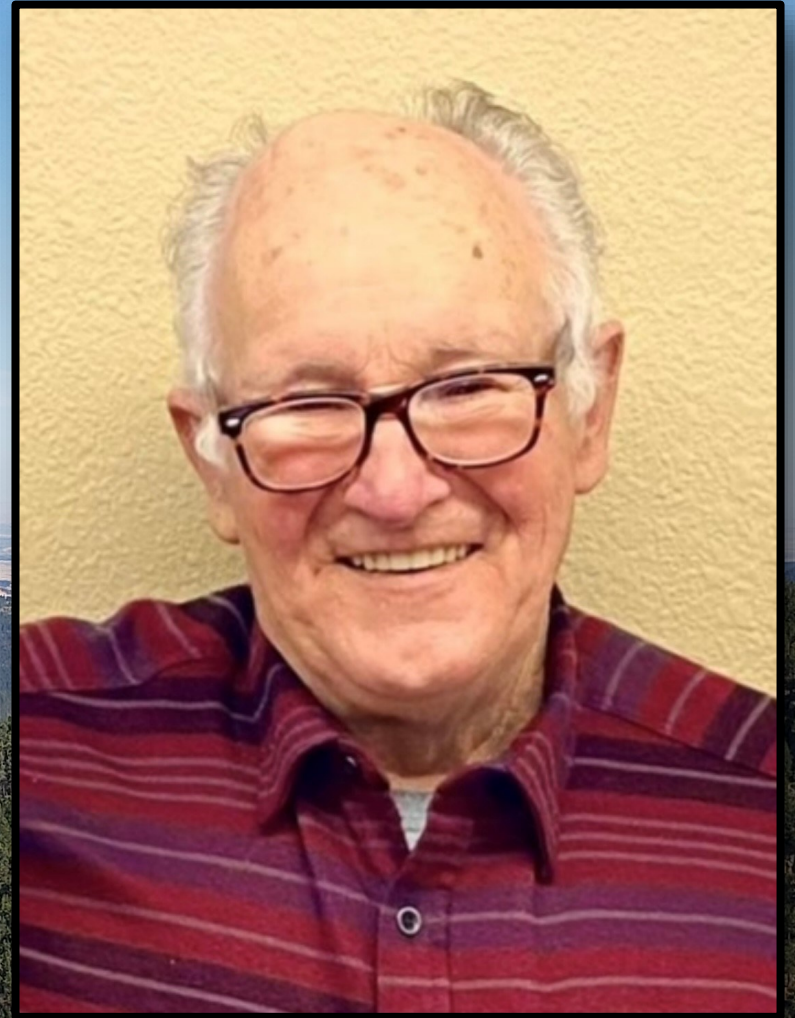


# *In Loving Memory*




*Clifford (Bill) Meyer*
