

Elton Lee Prouty

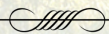

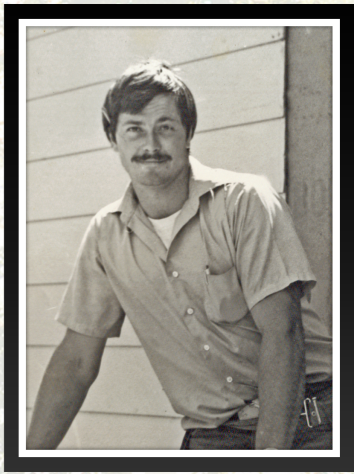
