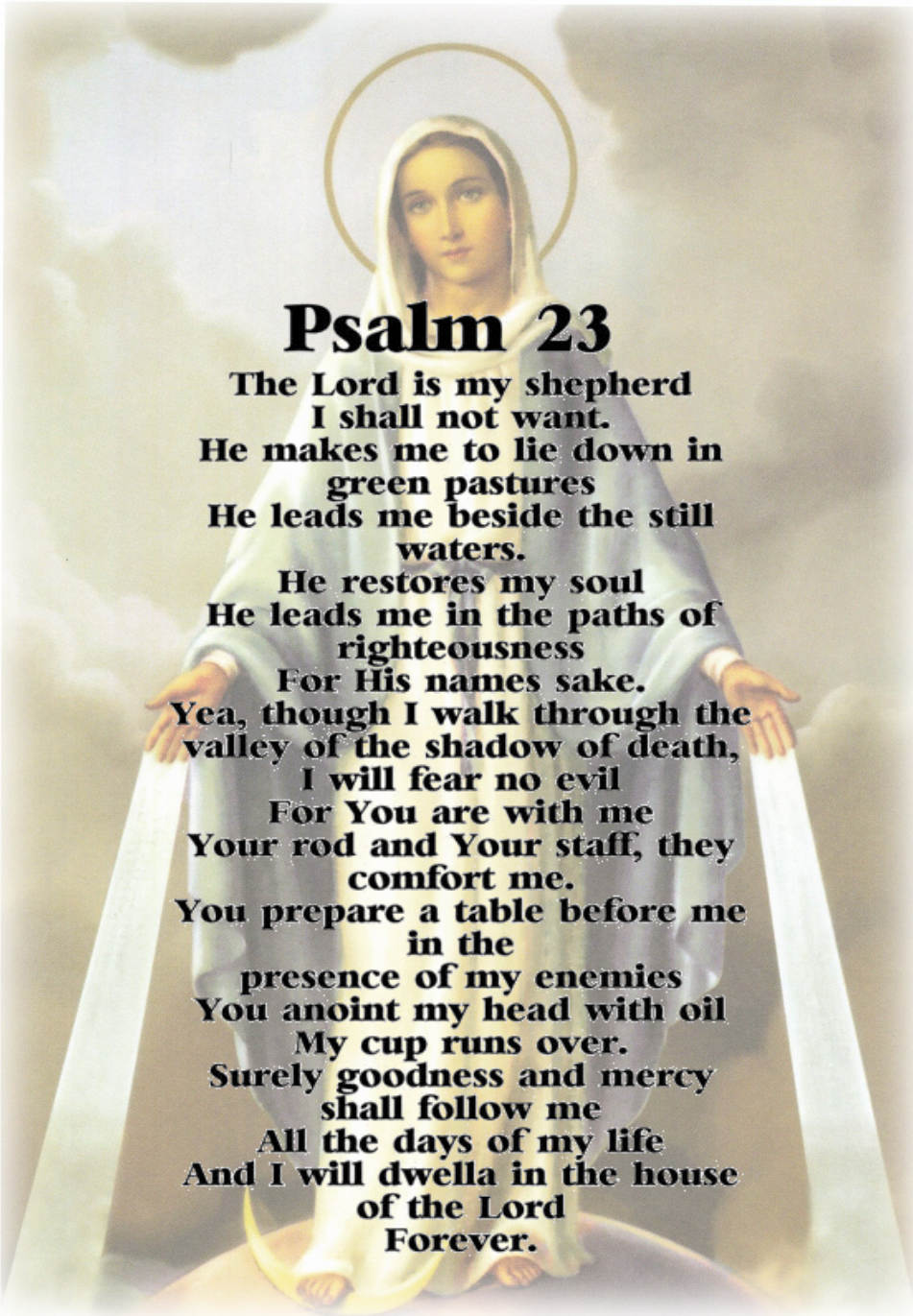




Psalm 23
