Ronald C. "Ronnie" Anders was born May 22, 1929, to Carl & Alice (Edwards) Anders, and was raised in the Marcus, SD, area where he worked on various ranches. On September 21,

1949, he married Wanda Raetz in Sturgis, SD, and began their life together.

In 1952, he got his first truck and started hauling gravel for various contractors. This continued until 1956 when he bought a class B permit and he began hauling grain and livestock for area farmers and ranchers; taking them to a number of local markets. Over the years, as business grew, he added trucks to his operation. His son, Stan, joined the business in 1973 and he continued trucking until he retired in 2014. 2016 saw Anders Trucking celebrate 60 years in business.
