

Agnes S. Ganeff

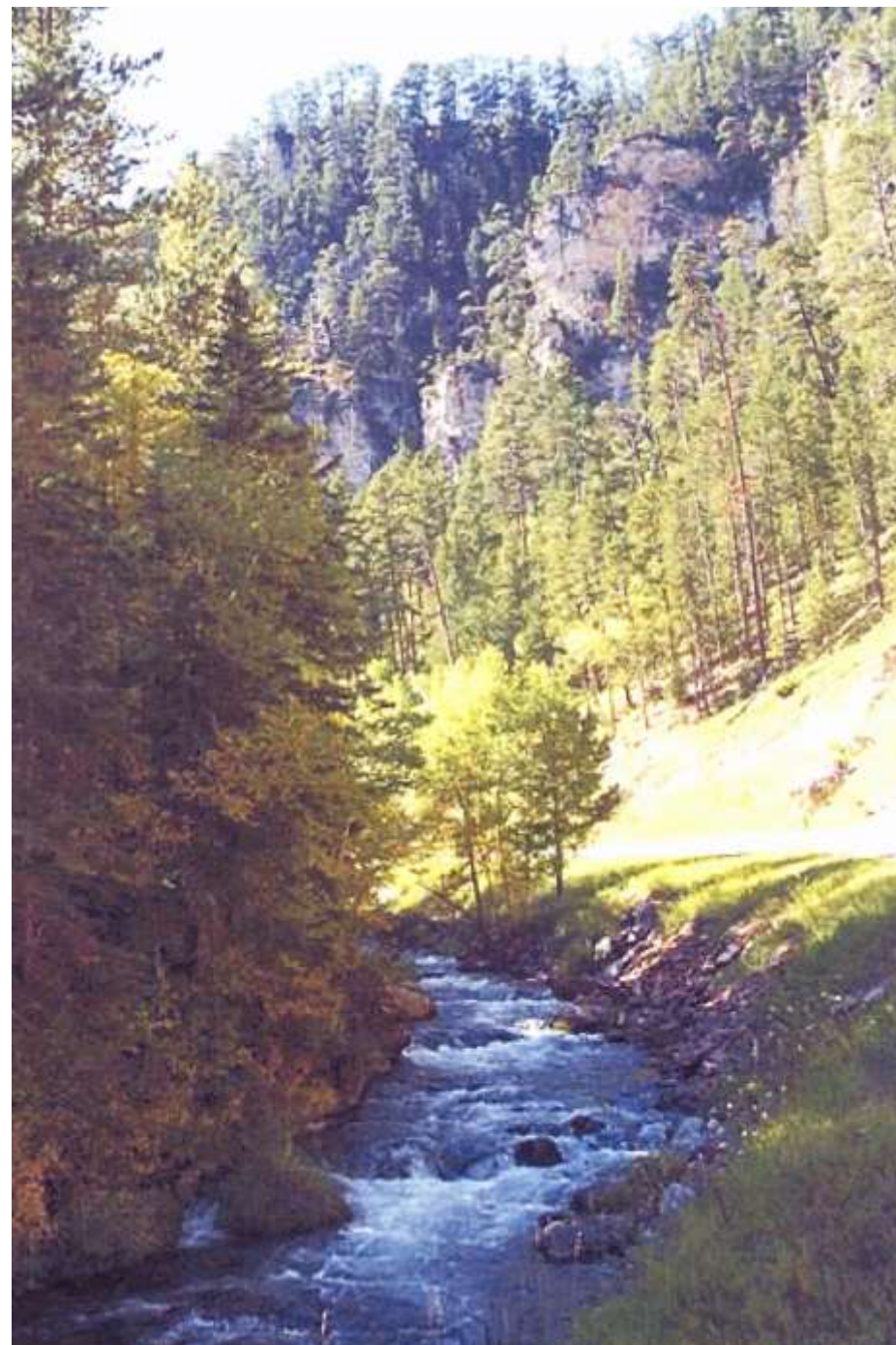
