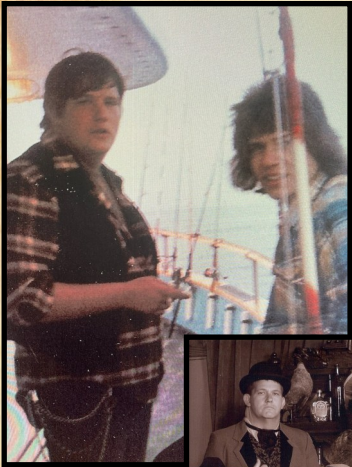


# *In Loving Memory*
