I am not there; I did not die.



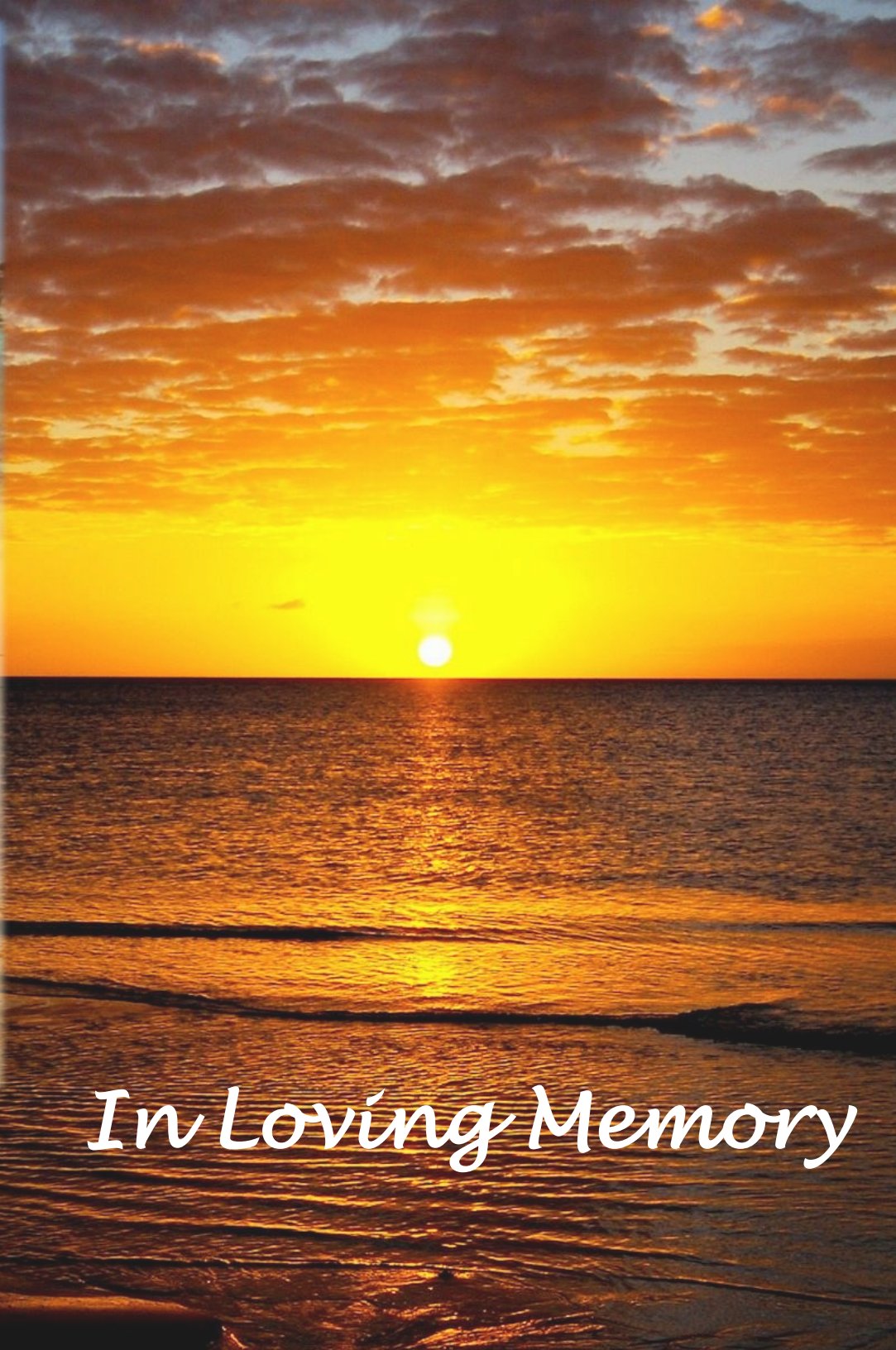
