Lynn A. Goodall, 72, Belle Fourche, SD passed away March 11, 2025 at Monument Health Spearfish Hospital. Funeral Services for Lynn will be at 10:30 AM, Tuesday, March 25 at Countryside Church in Spearfish, with visitation one-hour prior to services. He enjoyed being outdoors, spending time hunting, fishing, mowing and especially motorcycling, enjoying the weather. He was active in Celebrate Recovery, a large part of his life and a disciple of God, active in Countryside Church groups.


