



### Casey Joe Timm

Casey was born October 22, 1955, at Deadwood, SD, to William James "Bud" and Juanita Christine (Reiche) Timm.

Casey grew up on the family ranch East of Newell. He graduated from Newell High School in 1974.

On November 22, 1974, he married Debra Lee Wulf at Vale, SD.

Casey worked at Wheeler Lumber in Whitewood as a mechanic until 1978. He also worked as a mechanic for Ed Culver. He returned to the ranch and worked for his Dad until 1986 before working at a seed plant in Newell. In 1987, Casey was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis. He continued to work as a mechanic until his health declined.

Casey was active in his community. He was President for the Vale Water Board, and he helped the fire department and the Vale community.

Casey Joe Timm, 55, Vale, SD, died Friday, June 24, 2011, at his residence in Vale.
