For the happiness you brought



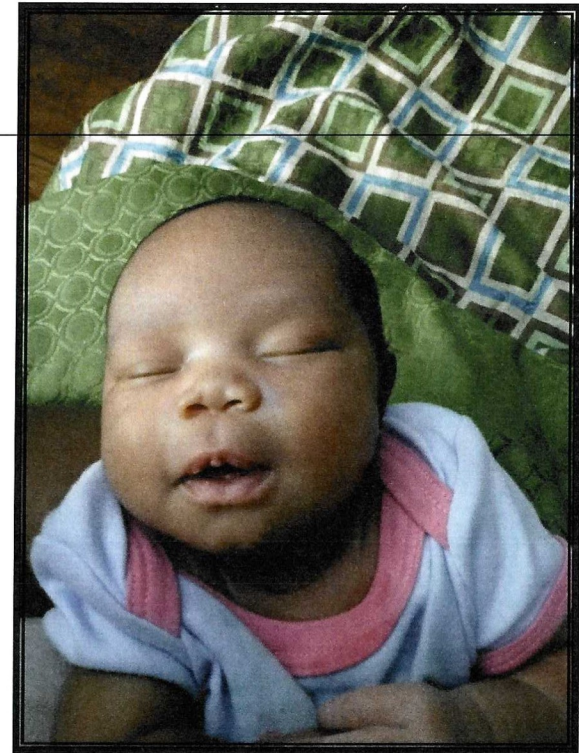
