Brandon loved music. He was looking forward to the new season of "House."

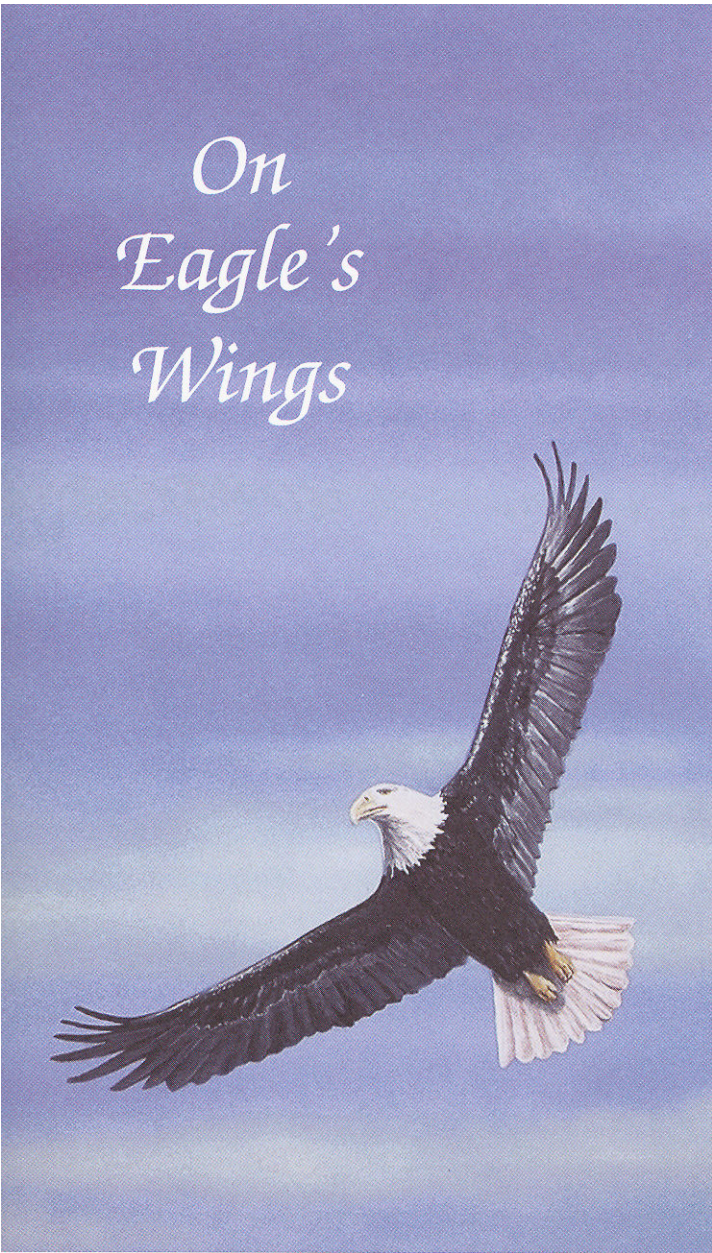
Brandon, 29, Lead, died Sunday, August 28, 2011, at his residence.

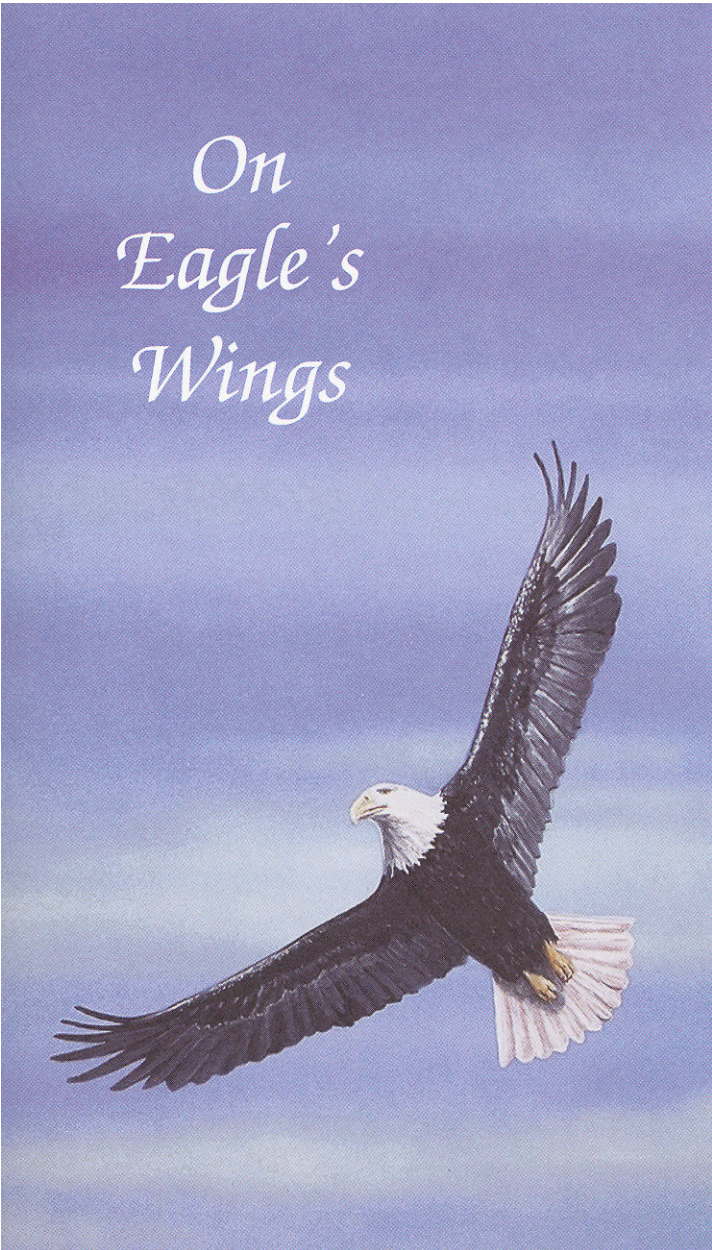
