





Ernest Wade Wilson was born on July 19, 1931 in Faith, SD to Vivian (Seaver) and W.H. "Bub" Wilson. He passed from this life on Tuesday, October 27, 2020 after a brief battle with cancer.

He engaged in ranching with his parents until 1989 when, due to health reasons, Ernest had to quit ranching. After leaving the ranch, he and Bea decided to settle and make their home in Sturgis.




