can really pass away.

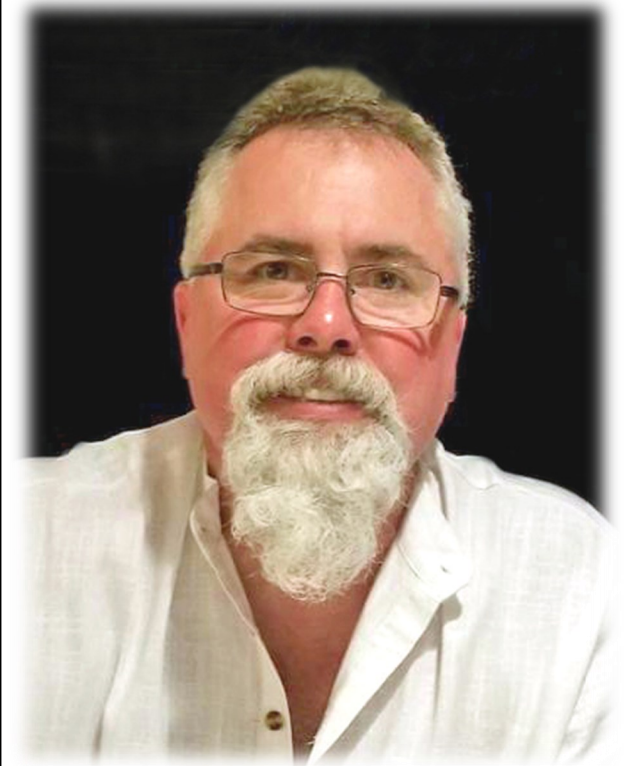
And think of him as living

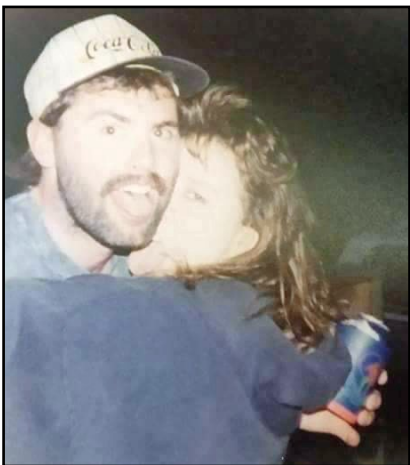
Sean lived in several surrounding towns including Bath, Ipswich, Cresbard and Chelsea.
