

## **Vivian Ellen Myrick**

Vivian was born August 28, 1929, in Aberdeen, SD to Harry and Inga (Olson) Gant. She attended 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> grade at the Brentford Consolidated Schools. She attended 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade at Augustana Academy in Canton, SD, graduating in May 1947.

Vivian started working March 15, 1948, for the Internal Revenue Service in Aberdeen. Except for intermittent breaks, she continued working there until the summer of 1953. Vivian moved to Denver where she met Harold Myrick, who was stationed at Lowry Air Force Base. They were married March 2, 1956, at Brewton, AL.

While Harold was shipped overseas, Vivian returned to live with her parents in Brentford. When Harold returned, they moved to Limestone Air Force Base, ME, before moving to Brentford, Redfield, and finally moving to Sturgis in the fall of 1959. Vivian worked at the Fort Meade VA Medical Center from February 1962 until her retirement in June 1985.


