Alfred Andrew Duprel was born August 21, 1956, in Sturgis, South Dakota, to Andrew and MaryLin (Connelly) Duprel. Alfred graduated from Sturgis High School where he played football and wrestled. He attended South Dakota State University and returned home where he worked on the family ranch.
