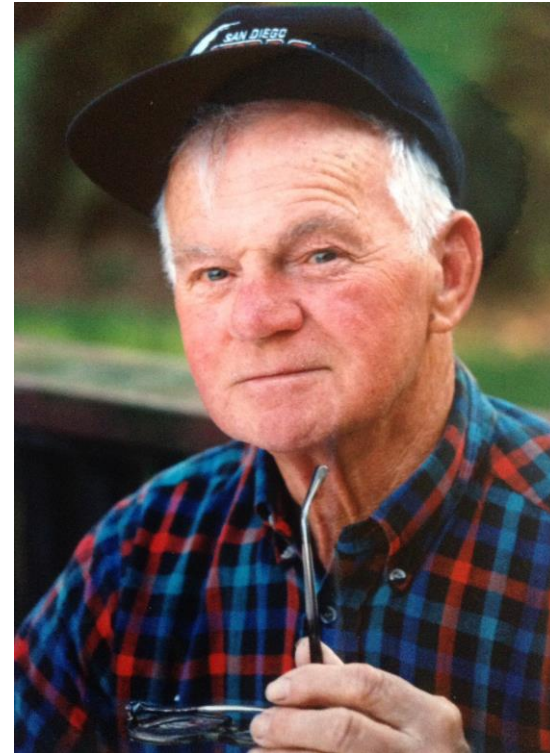




*God looked upon his garden
