**Where our King and Angels reside**

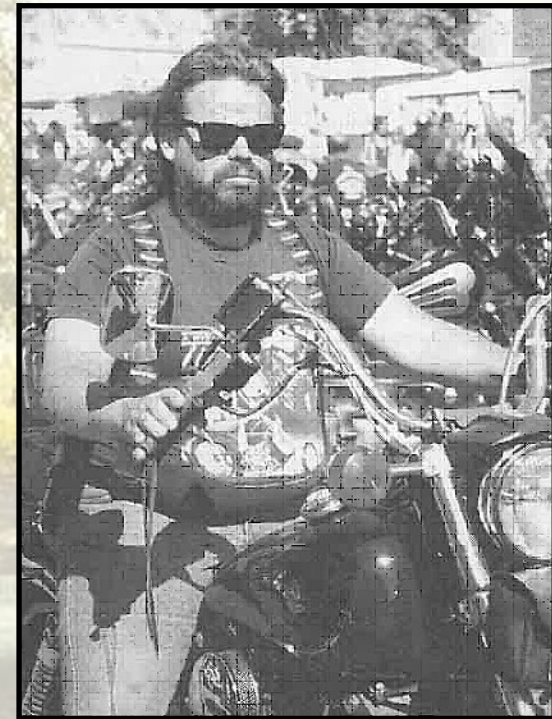
