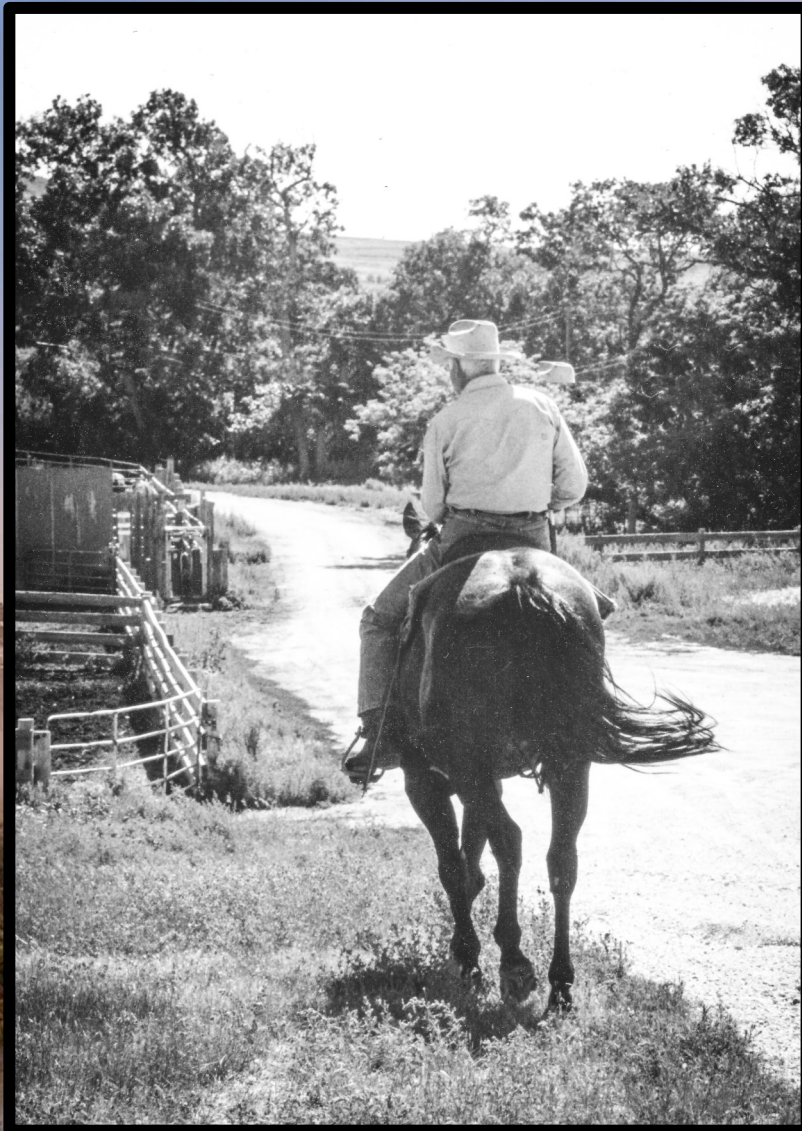

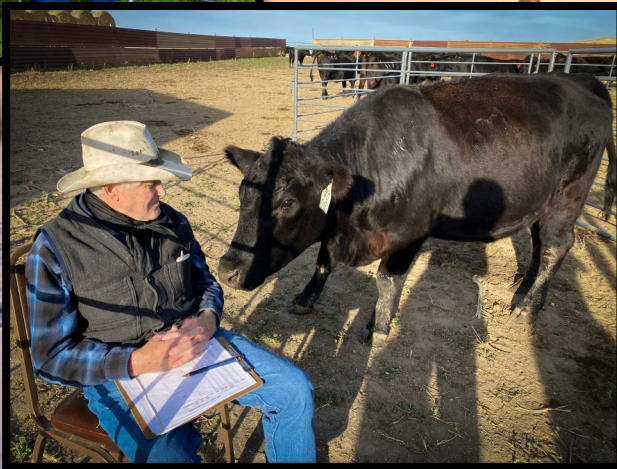
The family would like to thank Marsha Moore and the staff at Aspen Grove for their loving care of Hugh during these past few years.
