Kathy was born on July 28, 1930, in Rockham, SD, to Alvin & Marie (Worman) Buss. She grew up on her family's farm in the Rockham area and graduated from Redfield High School in 1948, where she was in band and chorus. She was active in the Congregational Church and with the church youth groups. In 1951, she graduated cum laude from St. Luke's School of Nursing in Aberdeen, SD. After her graduation, she moved to Chamberlain where she met her husband. On June 12, 1952, she married Donald Leroy Miller in Redfield, SD. She resided in Chamberlain for 19 years, then in Mitchell

for 8 years, then moved to Orem, Utah, and later retired in Sturgis. After her marriage, she joined the Roman Catholic Church and was a long-time parishioner of St. Francis of Assisi Church in Sturgis.

Kathy worked as a staff RN at Chamberlain Community Hospital from 1952 to 1954,
