

THINK OF ME

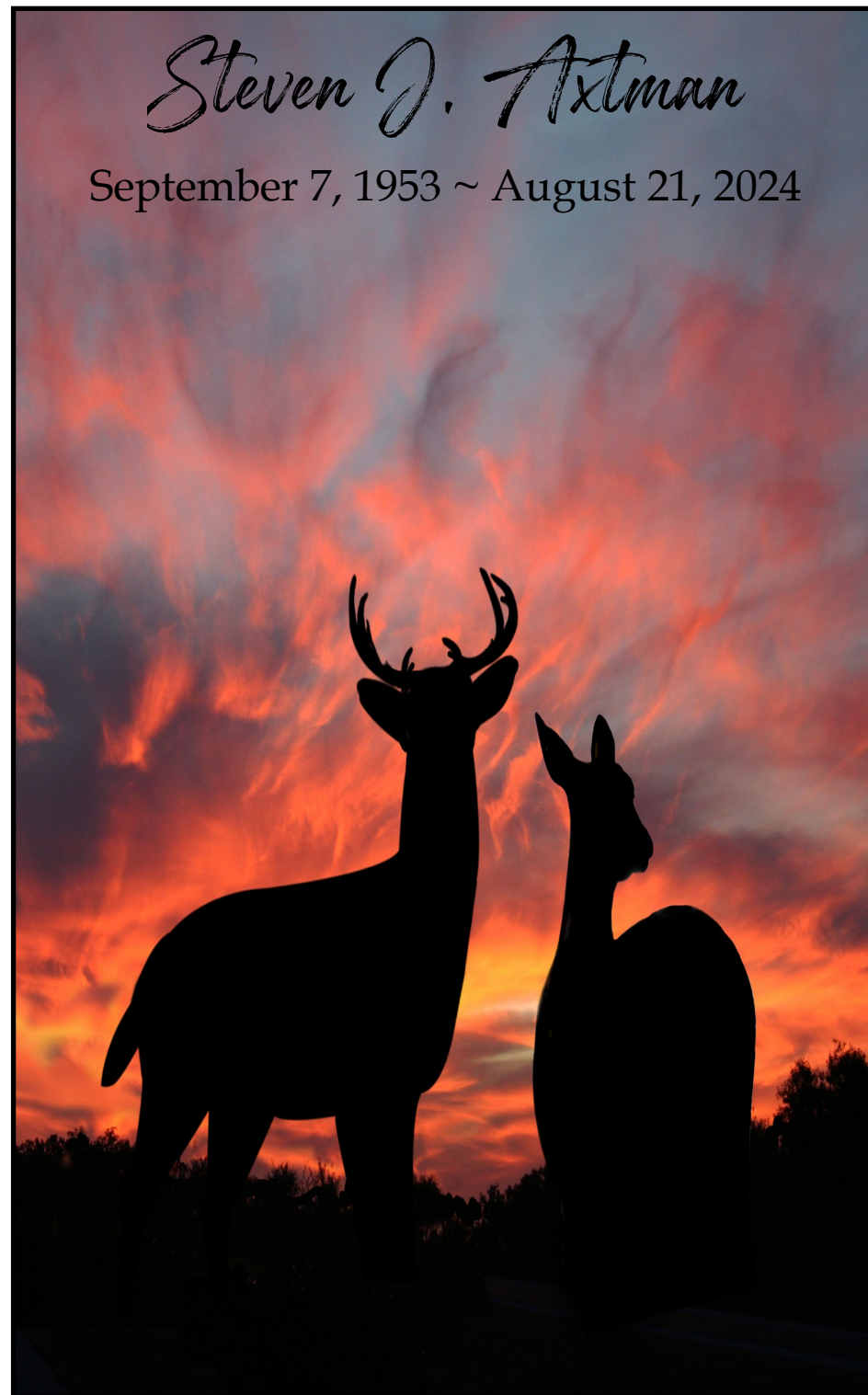
Heaven's not that far away,

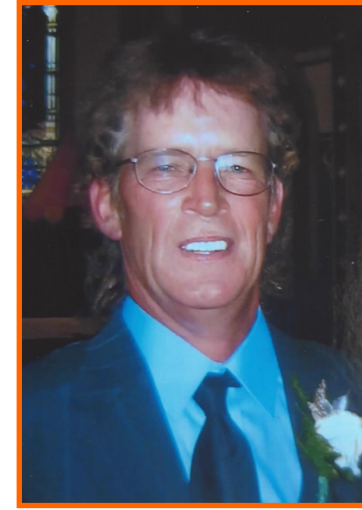
Steve married Ann Rounds, and they had two children, Elizabeth and Nicholas. Steve attended Mitchell Vo-Tech and became a journeyman plumber.
