Emily Veronica Bullerman was born on July 29, 1927 to Theodore and Martha (Kellen) Bullerman in Nobles County, near Adrian, Minnesota. She was raised on a farm and graduated from St. Adrian High School in 1945. She enrolled in the Presentation School of Nursing (McKenna Unit) at Sioux Falls in June of 1945 as a Cadet Nurse and graduated with a RN Degree in 1948. She was first employed at the Adrian Hospital.

On January 3, 1951, Emily married Bob Entwistle at St. Adrian Catholic Church. They made their home in Adrian until September 1951, when they moved to Mitchell, South Dakota. She was employed at St. Joseph's Hospital as a supervisor of the pediatric ward until October of 1955, when they moved to Huron.

Emily was employed in Huron part-time as a surgical nurse at St. John's Hospital until 1958. She was then employed at Welter Funeral Home, which she later owned and operated with Bob. She was a licensed funeral director for over 40 years from 1958 until she and Bob retired in 1998.

Emily was a member of Holy Trinity Catholic Parish, American Legion Auxiliary, VFW Auxiliary, and the Huron Area Senior Center. Emily and Bob believed in giving back to the Huron community and established a perpetual fund through the Huron Community Foundation.
