

After a courageous struggle, Jess Edward Nelson, age 91 of Sturgis, SD went to be with Jesus on July 27, 2016 at Sturgis Regional Hospital, Hospice Suite. Jess was born June 14, 1925, at his parent's home in Seward County, NE to Carl H. and Margaret J. (Baker) Nelson. He attended grade school at Utica, then moved and attended Beaver Crossing High School starting in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. He and his nephew, Norman Hohnbaum, were the only uncle/nephew pair to attend all 12 years of school together and graduate from Beaver Crossing.

After graduation, he worked on farms in the Waco, McCool, and York areas, and drove a semitruck. In 1946, he started work as a mechanic at the Ford garage in York. He was promoted to Service Manager in 1960 and maintained that position until 1974.

Jess married Donna Beth Elenora Blum June 22, 1947, in York. They moved to Sturgis in 1974 and Jess assumed the Service Manager position at Jacobsen Ford-Mercury. The position was held until he retired in 1990. He continued to exchange cars

between Ford dealerships for a number of years.

Jess spent his spare time through the years remodeling their first old home and then finishing the home they built in Blucksberg near Sturgis. He volunteered doing road maintenance in Blucksberg, organized the Blucksberg Home Owners Board and served as president, was a member of the Blucksberg Paving Board, and was a source of information for new and old homeowners in the development.

He was a baptized member of the Emmanuel Lutheran Church in York. He was a charter member at Faith Lutheran Church in York and served on many boards and committees until they moved to Sturgis. Jess was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Sturgis where he also served the church and participated in Bible studies. He also served on an ushering team. He was a member of The Westerners International. Jess was always there to help a friend or stranger in need.


Memorials will be distributed by the family to organizations that Jess supported.
