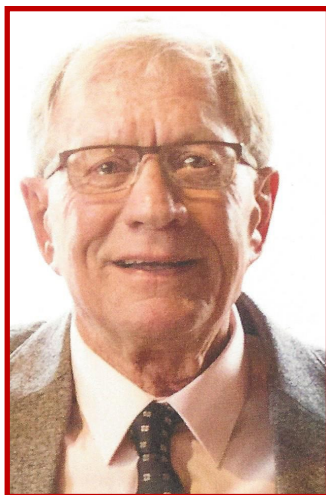
## In Loving Memory
