Mildred was born August 8, 1932, in Hurd Township (Lansford), Bottineau County, to Bessie (Zietz) and Lester Convis. In 1933, the family moved to Missouri. Mildred attended schools in LaMonte, Neosho and Springfield, Missouri; West Burlington, Iowa; and LaPorte, Indiana. The family returned to Lansford in January of 1944, where she graduated from Lansford High School in 1950.
