Thomas Patrick Smith, 79, of Sturgis, died Wednesday, May 22, 2019, at Sturgis Regional Hospital.

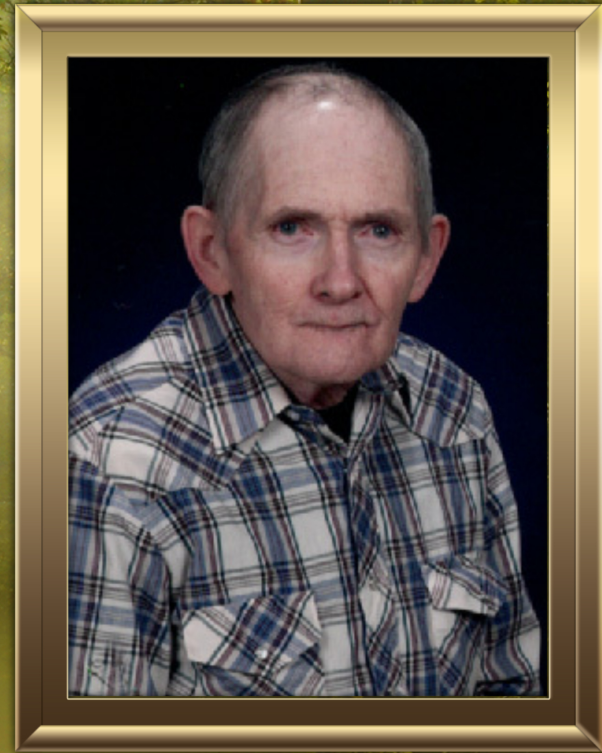
Survivors are his cousins, Gary and Vickie Weins, Ron and Cheryl Weins of Sturgis, SD.
