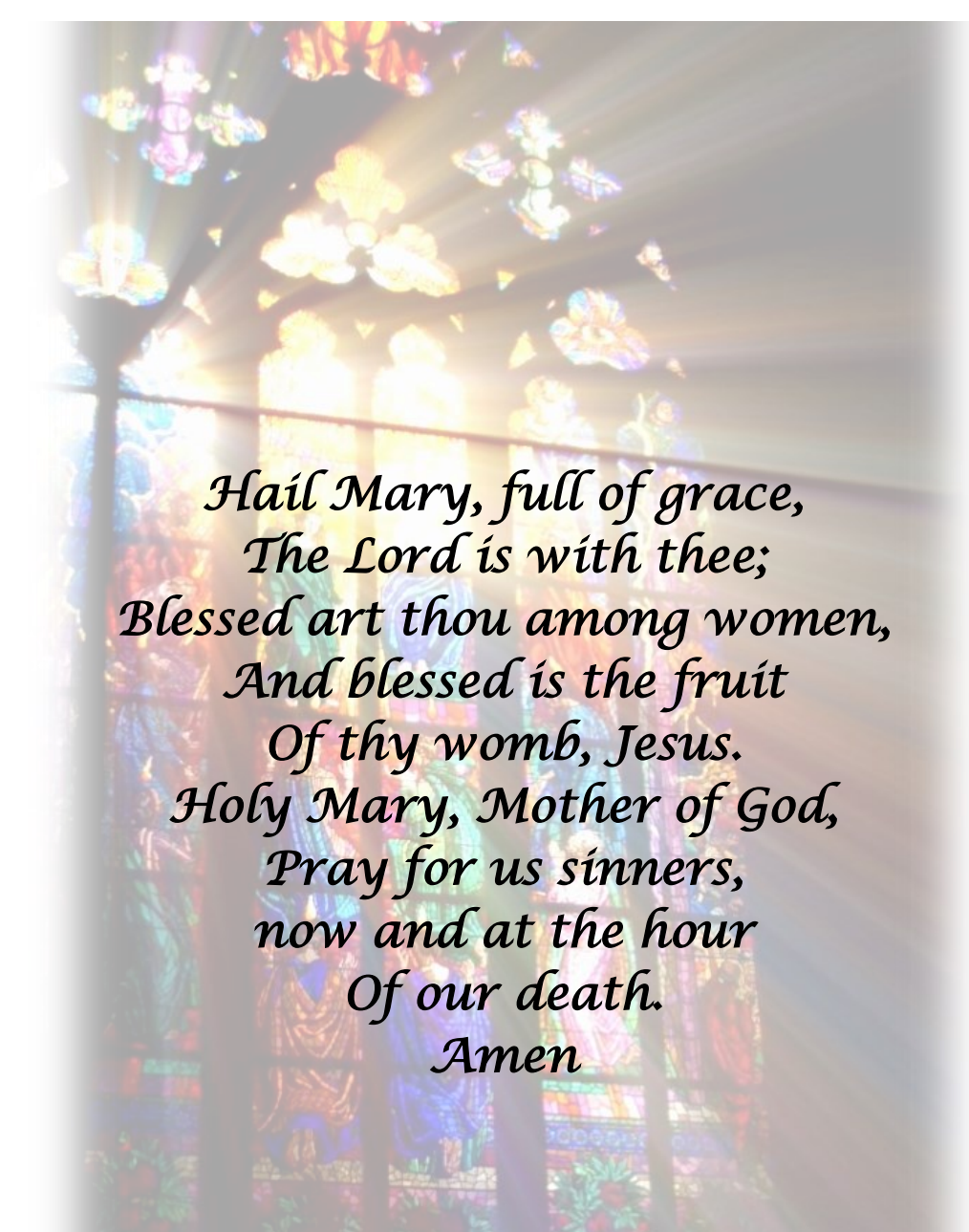

Herbert and Freda enjoyed traveling with their camper, visiting casinos, and playing cards.

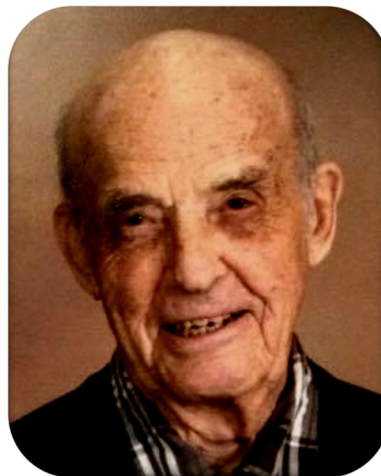
